





- FITP staff help facilitate parenting classes which are offered year round at the Parent Child Center and in various communities, during the day and in the evenings.
- A yearly catalog is widely distributed for all AHS district towns.

Current regional data as of May 1

- 38 active IFSP's
 - * 13 girls
 - * 25 boys
- 6 were born prematurely
- 3 are children with Down Syndrome
- 18 have language delays (5 also have diagnosed medical conditions)

Current data continued...

- 28 have Dr. Dynasaur/medicaid (74%)
- 13 are enrolled in CSHN
- 17 referred before age 1
- 5 eligible for personal care services

- Wherever is most convenient for the family and easiest for the child.






